Dear CCCS Parents & Guardians,

When children express gratitude for the gifts they receive while also showing compassion for others who have less, they are bringing to life an important part of the Christian teachings. Gestures both small and large – “Thank you for saying that.” “Would you like to borrow my coloured pencils?” “Can we have a bake sale to raise funds for Terry Fox?” “What can we do to help the people in Haiti?” – help create a culture of caring and result in “can do” attitudes. Following are two examples of how our students can demonstrate gratitude and compassion:

This Sunday is World Food Day and tomorrow is the last chance for students to bring in non-perishable items for the St. Vincent de Paul Society food bank. Supporting food banks is a very effective way to ensure our donations directly support the people most in need. Some of our students will be participating in an assembly tomorrow, followed by a walk, along with St. Andrew’s High School students, to the St. Vincent de Paul Society on View St. And *all* our students are encouraged to bring in a food item tomorrow, if they have not already done so.

Hurricane Matthew recently devastated Haiti, parts of Bermuda, the east coast of the US and our own Maritime provinces. As you know, Haiti has borne the brunt and suffered incredible damage to infrastructure and houses and over 1,000 people have lost their lives. Todd Fitzsimmons has a very personal connection with Haiti. This year, his family is hosting a student who spent five years in an orphanage in Port-au-Prince, before being adopted by a Canadian family. Todd has reached out to the Langford Fire Chief, Bob Beckett, who will visit our school after he returns from his own relief mission to Haiti this month. The Outreach Club has passionately taken up the cause and will be collecting donations next Thursday.
