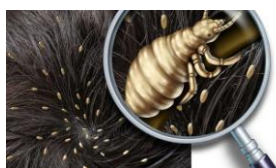

NO PARKING! Parents, we really need your cooperation with drop off and pick up procedures. Several times this week traffic has been backed up on Vancouver Street because a car is parked in the NO PARKING area and other cars are unable to pass through the lot. If your child is not at the gate when you drive up, then you **MUST** find another place to park on the street or in an empty, unmarked parking spot in the lot and walk to the school. **We do not allow parking near the playground entry gate for ANY LENGTH OF TIME.** Also, we would appreciate your assistance with either picking up your child by 3:15pm or encouraging your older child to make his/her way home promptly after school ends.
