There are many in our city (30% of children by some measures) who are living in poverty. We will be collecting non-perishable food items until next Tuesday, when our students will transport the gathered donations to St. Vincent de Paul Society where it will be made available to those who need it most. We encourage you to bring non-perishable items to the school. There are boxes in the front foyer for your contributions.

You may disregard the previous references to signup sheets on the bulletin board. All grades, K - 8 will use this online form instead of paper signup sheets. The link is included in this newsletter.




