## School Supply Ordering:

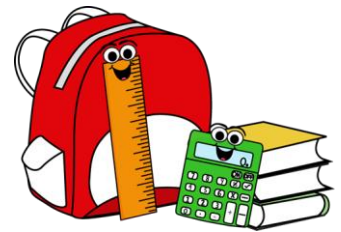
